The Yellowhouse Dancers

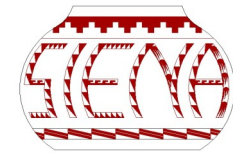
The Yellowhouse Dancers include some well-known singers and dancers that travel all around Indian country performing at powwows and other cultural events.

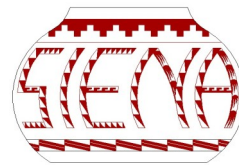
